



## SKCWA PADDLER TRAINING

All training will be carried out in accordance with the Australian Canoeing (AC) Award Scheme by AC accredited Instructors and Assessors acting under the auspices of a National Training Provider.

All Club members are encouraged to attend training courses to either develop their skills or keep them up to date. Sea kayak training qualifications can be attained by attending scheduled AC Award training offered by recognised training providers.

Participants must recognise that having attained certain skills at a training course does not automatically qualify them as proficient in the application of those skills in the varying conditions encountered at sea. On going practice in a variety of conditions will normally be required to achieve competence. Trip Coordinators and Instructors may require newly trained participants to demonstrate competence in the skills learned prior to participation in an on water activity.

The Club recognises formal qualifications awarded by other national or international organisations only when such qualifications have received cross accreditation from Australian Canoeing.

Members who have AC or cross accredited qualifications awarded by other organisations and non club training providers may be asked by a trip or activity Leader or Instructor to demonstrate key skills to ensure they are competent to participate in an on water activity.
